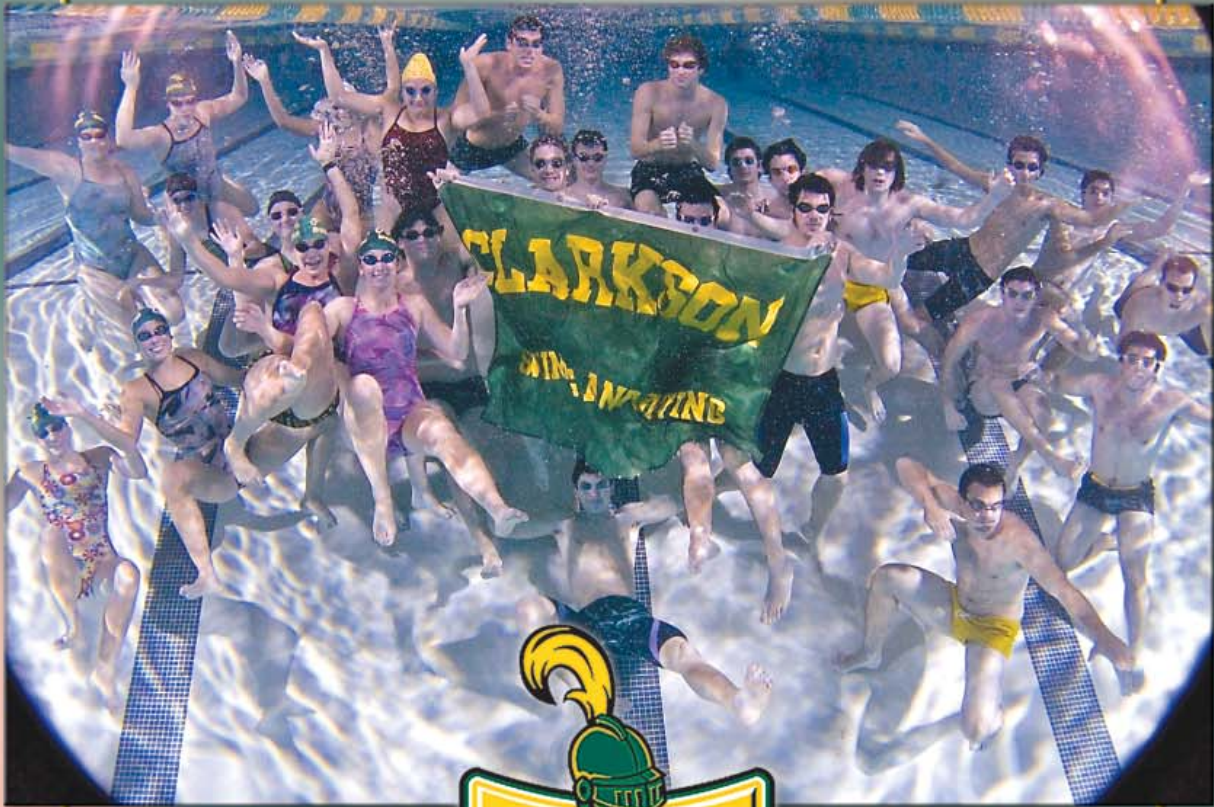

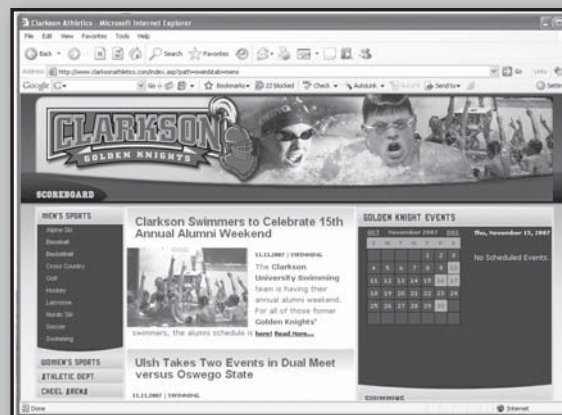

HEAD COACH - MICK MAGUIRE



Entering his 21st year with the Clarkson University Athletic Department, Mick Maguire was named the Golden Knights' Aquatics director and swim coach in 1987 and has guided the Green and Gold swim teams to continued success in conference, regional, and national competition.

Currently, Maguire also acts as the Intramural Director and Recreation Director. He served nine years as the women's tennis coach and has also served as an assistant women's lacrosse coach and equipment manager.

Under Maguire's tutelage, four swimmers have participated in the NCAA Championships, and his athletes have also excelled in the classroom where they have amassed myriad academic honors. The swim teams are also actively involved in community affairs and their annual 24-hour swim fundraising relay has benefited numerous charitable organizations throughout the years.

A 1985 graduate of Potsdam College, Maguire swam freestyle events for the Bears' swim team and was a member of Potsdam's 1982 SUNYAC Championship squad. He held the Bears' school record in the 500 free and currently holds the SUNYAC Championship Meet record in the 1650 free. A native of Malone, NY, Maguire was selected to the Franklin Academy High School Athletic Hall of Fame for his impressive performance as a high school athlete. Maguire set numerous swimming standards that are still in place today. The only Section X swimmer in history to break the five-minute mark in the 500 freestyle, a feat he accomplished twice, Maguire held school and Northern Athletic Conference records in five individual events, including the 50, 100, 200, 500 freestyle and 200 individual medley in addition to two relays, the 200 medley and 400 freestyle.

Maguire makes his home in Potsdam with his wife Sheila and their three daughters Malorie, Kaila and Kaycee.

ASSISTANT COACH



Gerard Flynn is entering his first season as the assistant coach of the Clarkson University Swim team. Flynn spent four seasons participating for the Golden Knights as an expert in the freestyle events. Flynn graduated in 2007 with a mechanical engineering degree and is continuing his education as a post-graduate at Clarkson.

KNIGHTS RETURN TO THE POOL FOR 2007-08

For the past few seasons, the **Clarkson University Swim** team has routinely accomplished two things each year: break school records and impress the competition at year-end events like the NYSWCAA and UNYSCSA. The 2006-07 **Golden Knights** met those standards and there is no reason to believe that things will change in 2007-08 as the team returns its best performers on both the men's and women's sides.

Guided by head coach **Mick Maguire** and assistant coaches **Gerard Flynn** and **John Bonneville**, the **Green and Gold** will be a young group with only seven seniors among its 33 members, but that certainly does not mean the team is lacking experience. Senior captains **Kristen Larsen** (Fort Edward, NY) and **Jaana Tuomala** (Wilton, NH) lead a solid group of women, while second-year captains, seniors **Corey Curtis** (Erieville, NY) and **Tom Manzo** (Liverpool, NY) as well as classmate **Nate Willsey** (Baldwinsville, NY) head a group of men ready to break through in the **Liberty League**.

During the NYSWCAA meet last February, several Clarkson standards fell in a number of categories, and those record breakers have returned this year to make for a formidable roster for the Golden Knights. Sophomore **Laura Shaddak** (Oswego, NY) spent most of last season earning **Liberty League Rookie of the Week** honors and finished the school year as **Clarkson's Female Rookie Athlete of the Year**. Shaddak routinely won her 50, 100 and 200 freestyle events for the Knights and set the school mark in the 50 freestyle. She also twice broke the record for the 200 freestyle before having her mark bested by teammate **Katherine Gawrys** (Ballston Spa, NY). Gawrys, a two-sport athlete her first two years at Clarkson, has set her sights on swimming full-time and should show even more improvement in her junior year.

Also leading the Knights in the freestyle events are senior captains Kristen Larsen, who will also be depended upon in the breast stroke events, and Jaana Tuomala. Junior **Adrienne Croneiser** (Boonville, NY) will play for points for Clarkson, as will returning sophomore **Katie Bragan** (Auburn, NY) and junior transfer **Bethany Beswick** (Williamson, NY)

In the specialty events, Larsen will lead the way in the breast stroke, while junior **Robyn Stone** (Potsdam, NY) can earn plenty of points in the back stroke when she isn't

helping out in the freestyle races. A fleet of freshmen will also compete in the back stroke for the Knights, including **Nicole Pera** (Jamison, PA), **Elena Kuo-LeBlanc** (Scituate, RI), and **Stephanie Seward** (Pembroke, NY).

On the men's side, no records were broken in 2006-07, but that doesn't mean the many talented upperclassmen aren't capable of challenging the marks again this season. Junior **Matt Ulsh** (Rochester, MN) has been a standout performer since stepping on campus two years ago and continued to swim at impressive paces last year. At the state meet, he finished fourth in the 200 butterfly and sixth in both the 200 and 400 individual medleys. Ulsh already owns the 400 individual medley mark, thanks to a record-shattering performance in his freshman season, but he is definitely capable of rewriting several other marks in the Clarkson record ledger.

Captain Corey Curtis also came through with an outstanding showing at the state meet last season and is primed for another great year in the breast stroke events. Clarkson is strong in many of the specialty events with Ulsh and Curtis in the lead. Senior Tom Manzo, junior **Will Gundling** (Westborough, MA), and sophomore **Dan Mandle** (North Chelmsford, MA) will lead the way for the Knights in the breast stroke. Sophomore **Tyler Mokay** (Liverpool, NY) will swim alongside Ulsh in the individual medley races.

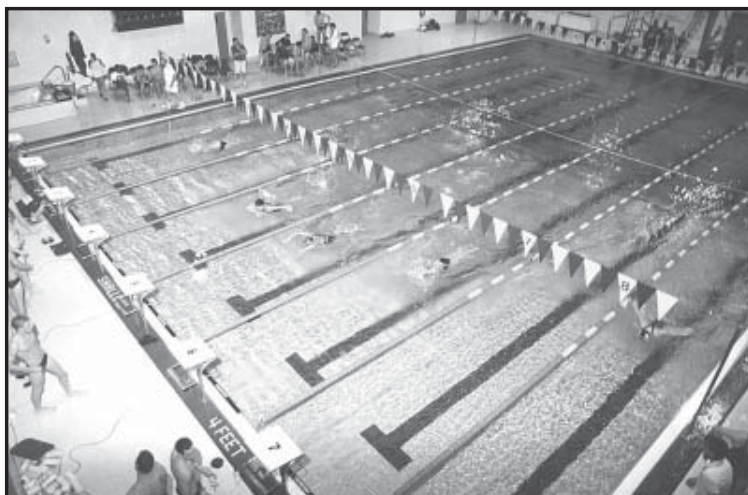
Even with the unquestionable strength in the back, breast, butterfly and individual medley, the Golden Knights are certainly no slouches when it comes to the freestyle races. Junior **Corey Van Woert** (Binghamton, NY) and Manzo will likely be the top performers for the Knights while seniors Nate Willsey, **Craig Fisher** (Rochester, NY), and **Jacob Marchal** (Castile, NY) can provide solid depth. Juniors **Evan Pedersen** (Geneva, NY), **Steve Ritter** (Johnson City, NY), **Dan Evans** (New Lebanon, NY), and Will Gundling and sophomore **Chad Klotzbach** (Basom, NY) have all contributed in the past and will be expected to continue to do so in 2007-08.

Several newcomers are expected to step in and participate right away, with good results. Freshman **Robert Stevens** (Lakewood, NY) and **Brendan Hofler** (Bethlehem, NY) will be called upon immediately to earn the Knights points in the back stroke and butterfly events, and **Kurt Schwarting** (Lowville, NY) will likely claim a spot among the top freestyle swimmers. Also making their debuts in the freestyle events this year for the Golden Knights are first-year swimmers **Clifford Long** (Valley Stream, NY), **Stephen Kelso** (Exeter, NH), **Justin Damaso** (Scituate, MA) and **Kane Streichert** (Norwich, NY).

TRADITION/NCAAS

Established as a varsity athletic team in 1983, Clarkson's swim team has one of the strongest alumni support groups among all of the athletic programs at the University. Always a loud supporter of other programs, the swim team is notorious for its competitiveness, athletic prowess, and rambunctiousness. The team is also heavily involved locally and has won numerous Clarkson University Team Student-Athlete Advisory Committee awards over the years.

In addition to being a boisterous group, the swim team has also performed as well as nearly any other program at the University, sending four swimmers to the NCAA Championships. Charlie Weisman '97 became the first Golden Knight swimmer ever to gain All-America recognition in back-to-back seasons. Weisman gained first-team All-America honors in the 100 butterfly in 1997 and also gained All-America recognition in the same event in 1996. Matt Szrama is the most recent swimmer to participate in the NCAA Championships, swimming in three events in 2005 in Michigan. Anne Donato '86 was the first Clarkson swimmer to compete in the NAAs, swimming at the 1986 nationals in the 200 butterfly and 400 individual medley. Jerry Miller '87 made a strong showing at the 1987 championships in the 50 and 100 freestyle races.

Taking a break from the confines of Fuller Pool during winter break, the Clarkson University Men's & Women's Swimming programs travel to the southern-most point in the United States for more than a week of winter training in early January.

The teams start off the New Year in the bright sun and remarkably warmer temperatures of Key West, FL. The Golden Knights practice schedule consists of two daily swims at the pool, one in the early morning and then once again in the afternoon (each lasting two hours), one hour abdominal and core strength workouts, and four-mile bike rides to and from the pool.

In the past few years, the Golden Knights have competed against the University of Connecticut, Rutgers, the University of Rochester, and conference foe Rensselaer in meets in Florida.

Although training and fitness are the primary reasons for the trip, there are always opportunities for the Golden Knights to relax and have fun. Between and after practices, the student-athletes play volleyball, soak up the sun, barbeque, and travel around the small island on the bicycles they have for transportation between the pool and the condominium complex where they reside.

“We have a better focus of what we're here for,” says head coach Mick Maguire on the purpose of traveling to Key West. “We come down here, we're around other college teams, and we're isolated from distractions. The atmosphere down here is great, because if we tried to do the workouts we do here in Potsdam, it would be almost impossible. We eat, sleep, and drink swimming for nine days, and the teams have fun. It makes for a great team builder.”

Each year, the teams raise the money for the trip by teaching swim classes to local youths, and also through the 24-Hour Swim Relay held every fall at Clarkson. Raising the funds makes the trip affordable for the students, as they only have to pay a small cost for the nine-day training trip.
